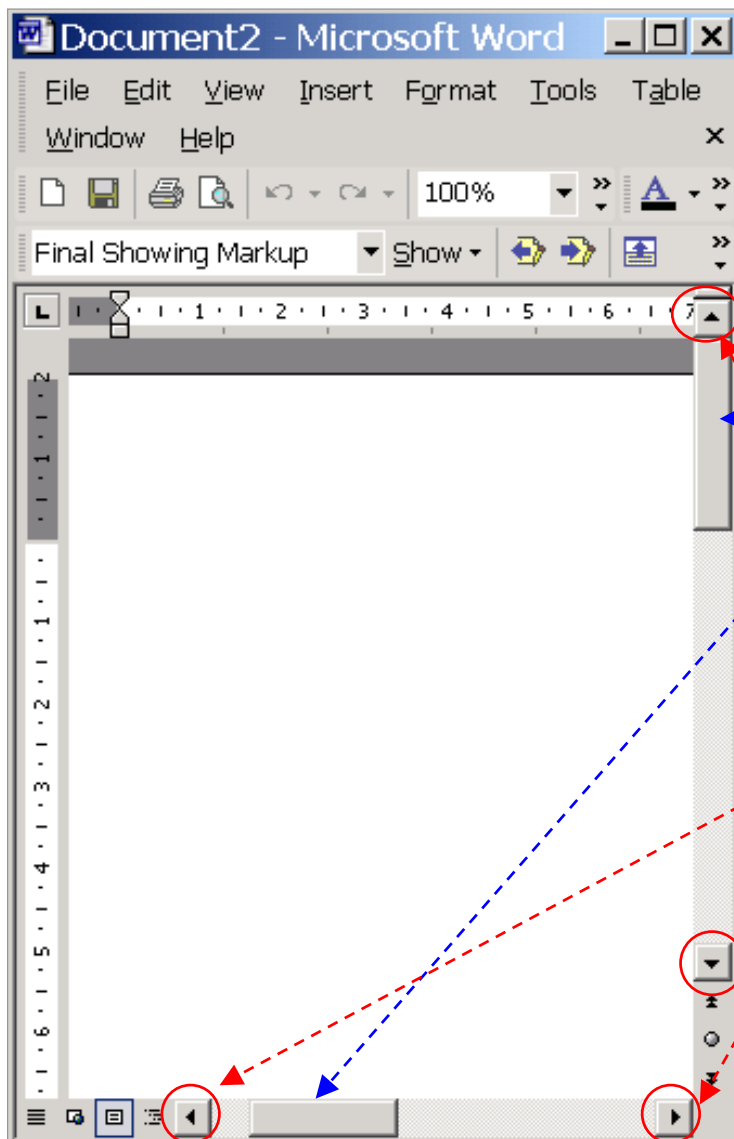


## Different Ways of Scrolling...

### What does 'scrolling' mean...?

If the content of the window you are looking at is larger than the window itself, you may have to move the contents up & down, or from left to right within the window to see it all. This is called '**scrolling**'. You can scroll in different ways, there is no right way, just choose the one that suits you best...



### 1. Using the scrollbars

**Scrollbars** - you can drag the grey box in the required direction

**Arrows** - Click on the arrows at each end of the scrollbar to move up & down or across the page



## 2. Using the mouse

In between the left & right mouse button is the **scroll wheel** which you roll backwards & forwards to move up & down the page.

## 3. Using the arrow keys

You can also use the **arrow keys** on the keyboard to move around the content of a page, which can have the same effect as scrolling... This is especially useful when scrolling down a long web page, such a shopping site with lots of products on it.
